

SJV 2011-12 Basketball Parents, Coaches, and Team Managers:

As a part of your SJV Basketball commitment, each family is required to work concessions during the regular season and home tournaments. Attached is the concession schedule for league play for the 2011-12 season.

Scheduling and Responsibilities:

The schedule will reflect that each family was scheduled to work as close to their child's game time as possible. Sometimes that may not be possible. If you have more than one child playing basketball, you may be scheduled to work more than one shift. If you are unable to make your shift, you must switch with another adult. **Failure to meet your scheduled time can result in your child's suspension from the next scheduled game, may jeopardize your child's future participation in the SJV athletic program and you will forfeit your \$100.00 concession fee.**

Two or more families are scheduled to work each shift. Workers are required to cover the gate admissions and concession areas. The admissions gate is also responsible for watching the bathrooms. The concession and gate areas are responsible for cleaning up the concession area and gym at the end of each day.

Fees: **Opt Out Fee**

While concession duties will remain our parent's volunteer responsibility, we are offering an opt-out option for the 2011-12 Basketball season for those parents that cannot meet their obligation.

Parents may now opt out of their concession volunteer responsibility for a \$100.00 fee good for the entire basketball season. Please make checks payable to St. John Vianney Athletics. Upon notification and payment, we will staff this time exclusively with hired and trained staff at the discretion of the Athletic Board.

Uniform and Concession Fee

The St. John Vianney Athletic Board will be collecting \$100.00 from each family at the beginning of each sport. This fee will cover uniforms and concession duties. When a family has fulfilled their concession duty (league and tournament) **and** has returned their child(rens) athletic uniform, the check will be destroyed. If, for any reason, the family obligation is not met, either by missing

an assigned concession duty or by not returning the athletes uniform by the designated date, then the \$100.00 fee will be forfeited to the SJV Athletic Board.

Concessions Responsibility

Concession revenue is an integral part of what is necessary to support SJV Athletics and keep the registration fees low. Concession duty is required for league games and tournaments that we host here at SJV.

When working concession duty, make certain that all items are in stock when needed. Make sure to keep the area clean and clear of all food. **The only person(s) that receive one complimentary beverage are the referees.** Under no circumstances should any family working concessions receive free food or beverage items. If you, your family or friends eat or drink something while you are working concessions, it is your responsibility to pay for those items.

The Athletic Board of St. John Vianney has clarified its concession duty policy and will no longer allow anyone under 18 to work the concession stand. If you are unable to fill your allotted time it is your responsibility to find a replacement

Tournament Coverage:

All Basketball families (except 5th grade) will also be responsible for working concessions during SJV hosted tournaments. All families will be assigned to work concessions for the grade their child is in, **even if your child's team is not entered in the SJV tournament.** For example, all 6th grade families will be assigned during 6th grade tournaments, etc.

Tournament concession schedules will be sent no later than Monday of the tournament week, via email to team managers and/or players. The revenues generated from all tournaments that St. John Vianney hosts will benefit the athletic program and ALL athletes.
