

Service

Service is a key component of our Catholic faith. Our expectation is that you complete twenty hours of service between June 1, 2011 and April 29, 2012. This is the minimum; you are more than welcome to exceed twenty hours.

Requirements:

- Complete twenty hours of service.
- Complete and turn in a signed Service Log Summary by April 29, 2012.

Examples of Acceptable Forms of Service for Confirmation Preparation:

- Participating in Summer SWEAT 2011
- Participating in the Summer Service Series 2011
- Working at Make-A-Difference Day
- Sorting food at a food pantry.
- Working at a meal program or soup kitchen.
- Helping out at a homeless shelter, nursing home, or hospice care center.
- Helping out at the Special Olympics.
- Working as a volunteer at SJV Vacation Bible School or Parish Festival.
- Coaching Faith-a-thon.
- Teaching the Faith or working as a catechist's helper.
- Helping out at Children's Liturgy of the Word.

Examples of Unacceptable Forms of Service for Confirmation Preparation:

- Doing chores at home.
- Walking your neighbor's dog.
- Cutting your grandparents' lawn.
- Selling concessions at a sporting event.
- Doing work for which you are paid.
