

**St. John Vianney
Market Day/Scrip Fundraising Designation
2010-2011**

By voluntarily participating in SJV's Market Day and Scrip fundraisers during the 2010-2011 school year, you have the opportunity to earn a credit towards your family's school tuition obligation for next year or towards your current year's Christian Formation fee. An added option is that you can retain the credit for yourself or assign it to a family which you designate.

Under this program, each participant has two options available to them:

Option 1 – Participants will receive a benefit equal to 50% of the profit raised as a result of their purchases through SJV's monthly Market Day and Scrip programs. The remaining 50% profit will go to SJV's Home & School general revenue fund. Participants can choose to retain the benefit for their own family or assign it to a family with students enrolled in either SJV's day school or Christian Formation Program. The family to whom the participant chooses to assign the benefit is termed the "designated family."

- If a designated family has student(s) enrolled in SJV's day school during the 2010-2011 school year, the benefit will be awarded as a credit to the designated family's tuition obligation for the 2011-2012 school year. If the designated family has only an 8th-grader enrolled during the 2010-2011 school year, instead of receiving a tuition credit in 2011-2012, they will receive a check for the amount of the benefit. The amount of the benefit will be limited to the designated family's tuition obligation for the 2011-2012 school year. Any benefit in excess of this tuition limit will go directly to the general revenue fund of SJV's Home & School Association.
- If a designated family has student(s) enrolled in SJV's Christian Formation Program during the 2010-2011 school year, the benefit will be awarded by check to the designated family at the end of the 2010-2011 school year. The amount of the benefit paid will be limited to the amount of Christian Formation fees that the designated family paid for the 2010-2011 school year. Any benefit in excess of this Christian Formation fee limit will go to SJV's Christian Formation Program.

Option 2 – 100% of the profit raised as a result of the participant's purchases through SJV's Market Day and Scrip programs remains within SJV. 50% will go directly to the general revenue fund of SJV's Home & School Association. The participant then assigns the remaining 50% to either SJV's Christian Formation Program or SJV's Home & School general revenue fund.

In order to communicate your chosen option to SJV's Home & School Association, complete the bottom portion of this form and return it to the SJV School or Parish Office by Friday, August 27. 100% of the profit from participants who do not complete a Market Day/Scrip Fundraising Designation form will go directly to the general revenue fund of SJV's Home & School.
